39% Suburban Maryland
19% DC

The Jewish population in DC has more than doubled

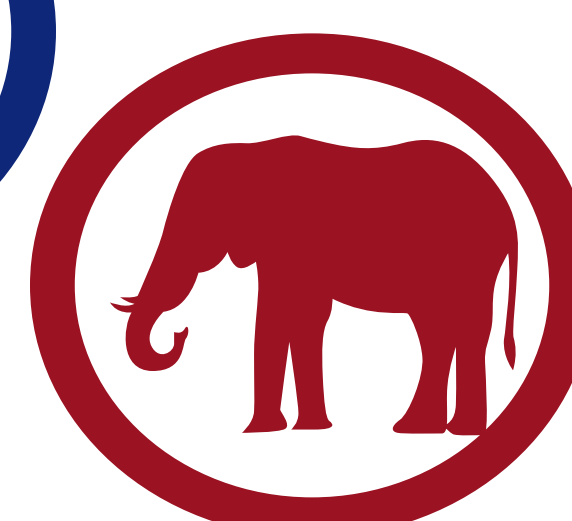
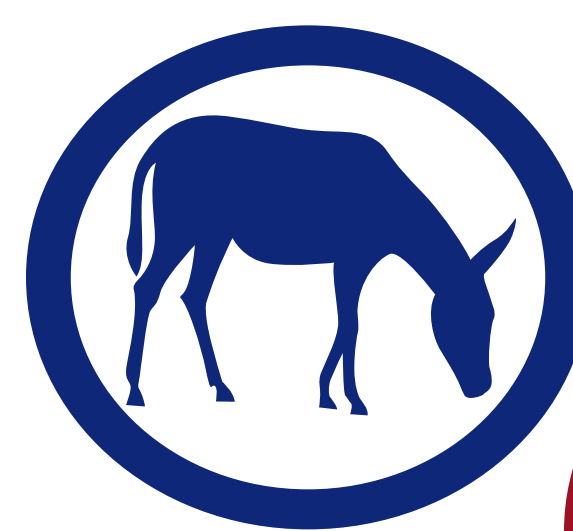
The Jewish population in Northern Virginia has grown by 80%

(Median age of Jewish adults is 45 compared to age 50 of Jewish adults nationally)

8% Other

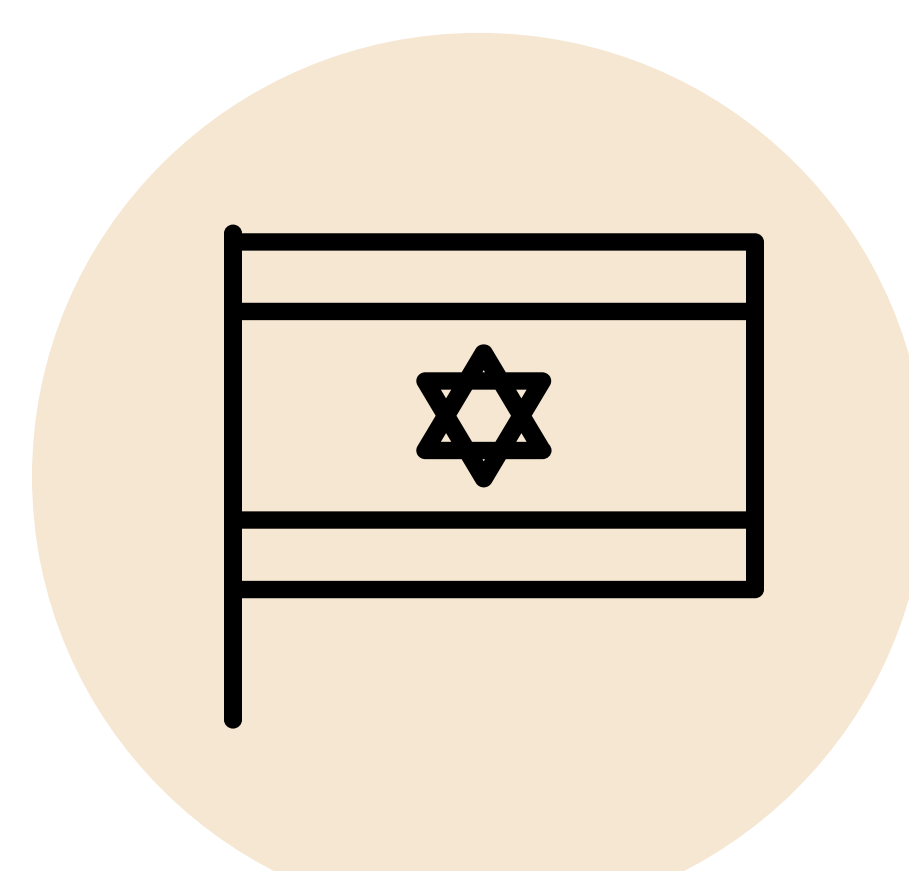
Family and Community Ties
